James: That's a really big family!

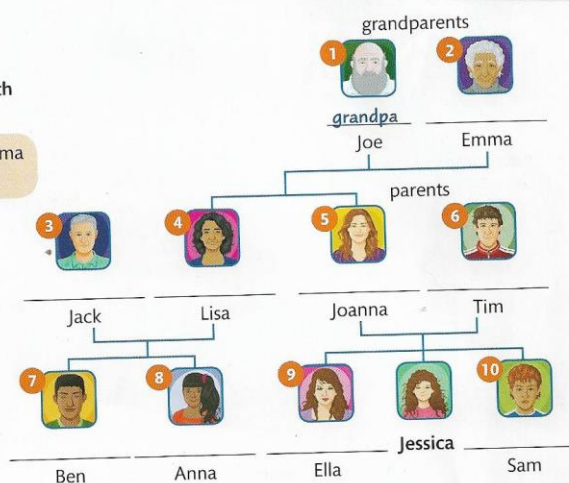

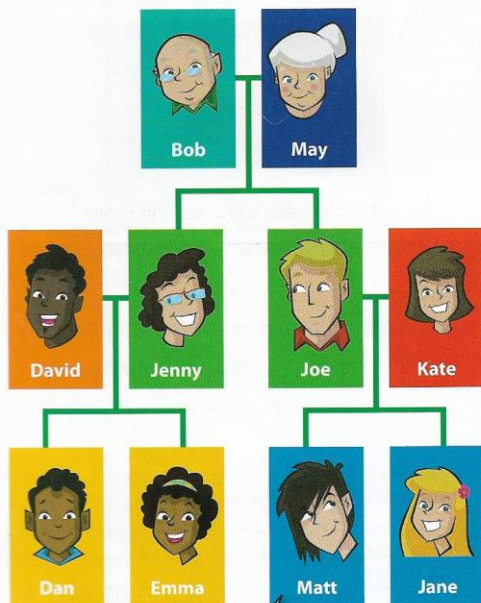

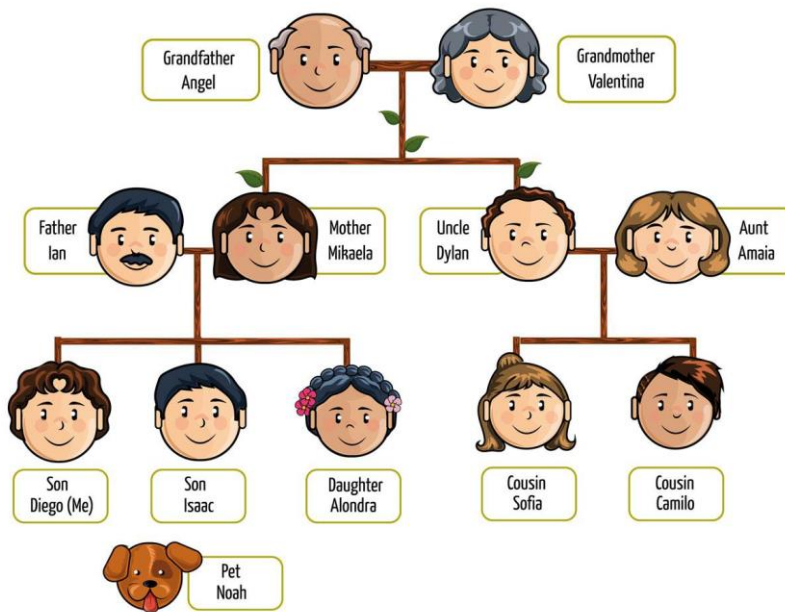
